"History 1968 - Present"

1968

BF & JW Cunneen was founded as a partnership by Bryan and Joyce Cunneen (David's parents).

1971

David joined the business helping his father with the installation of various architectural products including metal lettering, plaques, sun louvers and suspended ceilings – BF & JW Cunneen were sub-contractors to Wunderlich Ltd.

1972

Wunderlich Ltd is purchased by CSR and the sign section is put up for closed tender. BF & JW Cunneen are successful and acquire all the stock, old patterns and customer list, business starts in the garage at home but soon moves to leased premises in Meadowbank. BF & JW Cunneen change their name to Cunneen & Company Pty Ltd.

1974

After a successful couple of years the company purchase their own premises – a 700m² factory in Greenacre, they also purchase their first pantograph engraving machine and set up a spray painting booth. The company is now busy fabricating metal letters, buying in cast letters and plaques and finishing them, enamel filling recess faced cast letters and engraving plaques and door signs.

1976

Cunneen & Co Pty Ltd are successful with their first big Government tender – the supply of illuminated signs for the NSW State Police. They also find it necessary to establish their own foundry department – this ensures the critical on time delivery required for commemorative plaques and control over casting quality and integrity.

1977

The Company decides to purchase additional premises at Condell Park with the idea to split the clean work of engraving, fabrication and spray painting from the foundry work.

1980

Cunneen & Co Pty Ltd moves to their present 2,000m² factory in Granville (now renamed Holroyd) and begin to purchase additional equipment, including our first computer engraving machine to assist with our contract to supply name badges and desk nameplates to the Commonwealth Bank.

1984

We invest in another heavy duty computer engraving machine and are heavily involved with production of work for both NAB and Commonwealth Banks, associations we were to keep for the next 20 + years until they outsourced control of facilities.

1985

Bryan Cunneen retires at age 55, David at age 31 purchases the business and moves from running production to controlling the whole operation.

1988

Further investment in equipment including a 3m x 2m computer controlled router and a 75kw high frequency furnace for our foundry department.

1997

The company features on the front cover and in a 10 page article in the Industry Magazine "Signs Australasia".

1998

Cunneen & Co Pty Ltd entered and were awarded a coveted "First Place" in the USA based Electric Sign Competition for the outstanding illuminated 'Darling Walk' sign in Darling Harbour, the first Australian Company to have entered and won such a high profile award.

1999

Cunneen & Co Pty Ltd donates bronze commemorative plaques to assist with our bid for the 2000 Sydney Olympics Games. We then had the pleasure and honour of producing signage for the games venues.

2001

Cunneen & Co purchase Hadfield Sign & Print, a sign manufacturing and screen printing company located in Padstow, Sydney. Later that same year they purchase Archi-Type Engraving, an engraving and sign making company located in West Gosford...staff levels now reach 45 and sales continue to grow.

2001

The Cunneen Group continue to prosper and feature strongly at the National Sign Awards with many Gold, Silver and Bronze awards. Investment in quality equipment continues with purchases of new digital printing equipment, custom built specialised welding tables and jigs, overhead cranes, 3.6m press brake, 4m guillotine and semi-automatic screen printing equipment.

2011

Nicholas March builds on his position as General Manager allowing David Cunneen to move away from day to day operations and focus on direction and strategy.



2017

The operation in Gosford (Archi-Type Engraving) is sold.

The Hadfield Signs operation is consolidated and moved to Peel Street.

Staff levels settle at around 40 with additional and replacement team members in sales, production and project management, the company successfully completes and continues to work with high profile clients and projects such as the Re-branding of Anglican Retirement Villages, Internal and External signage for Canberra Hospital, new signage is manufactured and installed at Ayres Rock Resort.

Asset purchases include a new crane truck, x2 new Roland eco-solvent wide format and x1 Oce UV-ink flatbed printers, new LED lighting throughout the factory, new MultiCam CNC router, Gravotech engraving machine and replacement installation vehicles.

Continued focus on our website and marketing yields positive results and generally business is in great shape with positive growth anticipated.

PHILLIP HUGHES 1988-2014

Macksville-born Phillip Hughes became the youngest man to score a century in a Sheffield Shield final when he posted 116 at the SCG during NSW's win against Victoria in 2007-08.

The dashing and unorthodox left-hand batsman had earned his first NSW cap earlier that season, aged just 18.

Hughes made three more first-class centuries at the SCG, having quickly become a crowd favourite.

The Boy from Macksville also became a hugely popular member of the world's cricketing elite, forging friendships at home and abroad as fast as he accumulated runs.

Hughes scored 9023 first-class runs at 46.51, compiling 26 hundreds from 114 matches. He became Australia's 408th Test player during the 2008-09 tour of South Africa — a series in which he also became the youngest player to post centuries in both innings of a Test, and this, in only his second ever Test match.

He played three Tests at the SCG, narrowly missing a century in the 2012-13 summer when dismissed for 87 against Sri Lanka.

Hughes faced his last ball on 25 November 2014, playing for South Australia against NSW at the SCG.

His death two days later united the sporting world in grief, with Cricket Australia awarding him 63 not out forever — his final score at the SCG. His funeral was attended by thousands, with many more watching
